RE: Increasing the Reimbursement Rate for Mirena – HCPCS J7302

The purpose of this policy transmittal is to notify providers that, effective for dates of service February 1, 2015 and forward, the Department of Social Services (DSS) is revising the fee for HCPCS J7302 (Levonorgestrel intrauterine contraceptive; Mirena IUD).

This change will apply to providers using the physician office and outpatient fee schedule to bill for the Mirena contraception. The new fee will be \$810.51 and will be listed on the physician and outpatient fee schedule by the effective date. These changes apply to services billed under the HUSKY Health program (HUSKY A, B, C and D).
