

Pediatric Health Measures

HEDIS® MY 2021

1. **Child and Adolescent Well-Care Visits (WCV)** – The percentage of members 12-21 years of age who had at least one comprehensive well-care visit with a primary care provider (PCP) or an OB/GYN practitioner during the measurement year. Note: the age group is a subset of the measure for 3-21 years.
2. **Immunizations for Adolescents (IMA) - HPV** – The percentage of adolescents 13 years of age who have completed the human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine series by their 13th birthday. Note: the measure is a subset of the measures requirement.

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3. **Asthma Emergency Room** – Percentage of members 2-20 years of age diagnosed with asthma during the measurement year with one or more asthma-related emergency room (ER) visits.
4. **Behavioral Health Screening (Ages 1-18)** – The percentage of members 1-18 years of age who received an annual behavioral health screen within the 12 months prior to their birthday.
5. **Developmental Screening in the First Three Years of Life (DEV-CH)** – The percentage of members screened for risk of developmental, behavioral, and social delays using a standardized screening tool in the 12 months preceding their first, second, or third birthday.

Adult Health Measures

HEDIS® MY 2021

1. **Breast Cancer Screening (BCS)** – The percentage of women 50-74 years of age who had a mammogram to screen for breast cancer. *Note: Eligible population is women 52-74 years of age as of December 31st of the measurement year.*
2. **Chlamydia Screening in Women (CHL)** – The percentage of women 16-24 years of age who were identified as sexually active and who had at least one test for chlamydia during the measurement year.
3. **Comprehensive Diabetes Care - Hemoglobin A1c (HbA1c) Testing (CDC)** – The percentage of members 18-75 years of age with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) who had an HbA1c test performed during the measurement year.
4. **Use of Imaging Studies for Low Back Pain (LBP)** – The percentage of members 18-50 years of age with a primary diagnosis of low back pain who did not have an imaging study (plain X-ray, MRI, CT scan) within 28 days of the diagnosis.

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5. **Post-Admission Follow-up Within Seven Days of an Inpatient Discharge** – Percentage of inpatient medical or behavioral health admissions for members 21-75 years of age with a claim for post-admission follow-up with a physician, PA, or APRN within seven days of the inpatient discharge. Medical admissions are defined as all admissions that are not maternity or surgery related.

Challenge Pool Measures

1. **Pediatric - Behavioral Health Screening (Ages 1-18)** – The percentage of members 1-18 years of age who received an annual behavioral health screen within the 12 months prior to their birthday.
2. **Adult - Comprehensive Diabetes Care - Eye Exam (CDC)** – The percentage of members 18-75 years of age with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) who had an eye screening or monitoring for diabetic retinal disease. This includes individuals with diabetes who had one of the following: a retinal or dilated eye exam by an eye care professional (optometrist or ophthalmologist) in the measurement year, a negative retinal or dilated eye exam (negative for retinopathy) by an eye care professional in the year prior to the measurement year, or a bilateral eye enucleation anytime during the member's history through December 31st of the measurement year.

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
